<b>Review of December Minutes - Donna</b>	There were no changes to the minutes.		
<b>Listening Session Question Review - Marissa</b>	<p>Listening sessions are part of the CHA process. The target of eight to ten sessions will be done in March and April this year in partnership with Duke Health. Committees will use the data during the Community Health Improvement Plan process. Marissa asked the committee to review and revise the listening session questions they developed pre-COVID. The listening sessions were planned for 2020 but were postponed to 2021. The committee decided to keep the following questions previously developed:</p> <p><i>Community Health and Housing Questions</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If you had a friend/knew someone moving to Durham, what resources would you use to help them find a place to live? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ What are the most important things you consider when finding a place to live?</li> </ul> </li> <li>• How does where you live make you feel? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Facilitator should ask additional follow up questions based on responses.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Donna mentioned that she or Heather Mountz could ask Duke University School of Nursing students to help with the listening sessions.
