<p>Participation in Dr. Nowell's Research Project <i>All</i></p>	<p>Make a decision on participating in Dr. Nowell's research project.</p> <p>Dr. Branda Nowell has a research project she would like to see if the task force would be interested in. From Dr. Nowell:</p> <p>I'm teaching a doctoral qualitative research methods class this coming semester. We generally take on a joint qualitative project. One idea I had that I thought may be useful to the workgroup is to look at health partnerships in North Carolina who are seeking to engage community representation about the models they are using, the challenges, lessons learned, etc.</p> <p>Commitment- Partnership leadership participate in key informant interviews to assess partnerships that have engaged community members.
