# North Carolina's Vision For Managed Care

"To improve the health of North Carolinians through an innovative, whole-person centered, and well-coordinated system of care that addresses both the medical and non-medical drivers of health."

## What is Happening in NC Medicaid?

### **NC Medicaid Managed Care**

- Name for new Medicaid program
- Offered by "health plans"
- There will be multiple types of health plans
- Each health
   plan coordinates most
   health services, including
   physical health, behavioral
   health, and pharmacy and
   addressing unmet health
   related resource needs

#### **NC Medicaid Direct**

- New name for current Medicaid fee-forservice program
- Provides many of the same health services as health plans
- People who do not get their Medicaid services through a health plan will continue to receive health care through NC Medicaid Direct and LME/MCOs

Every person who is eligible to get Medicaid will still get Medicaid.

## **Highlights of Medicaid Transformation**

- New System Delivery System
- Whole-Person Focus and Healthy Opportunities Initiative
  - Physical and Behavioral Health Integration: Payment and Delivery
  - Addressing Unmet Social Needs: Healthy Opportunities
    - Anticipate award of Lead Pilot Entities in spring 2021 and service delivery launch in early 2022
- Primary Care and Local Care Management Investment
  - Advanced Medical Home Program
  - Behavioral Health Home and Care Management
- Value-Based Payments
  - Health plans are required to increase participation in value-based payments after launch

## **Moving to NC Medicaid Managed Care**

- Approximately 1.6 million of the current 2.5 million Medicaid beneficiaries will transition to NC Medicaid Managed Care.
- Beneficiaries will be able to choose from 5 health plans
  - WellCare
  - UnitedHealthcare Community Plan
  - HealthyBlue
  - AmeriHealth Caritas
  - Carolina Complete Health
    - Serving regions 3, 4, and 5



 The Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians (EBCI) Tribal Option will manage the health care for North Carolina's approximately 4,000 Tribal Medicaid beneficiaries primarily in Cherokee, Graham, Haywood, Jackson, and Swain counties.

All health plans and all regions will launch on July 1, 2021.

## **NC Medicaid Direct and Tailored Plans**

#### **NC Medicaid Direct**

• Some beneficiaries will stay in NC Medicaid Direct (fee-for-service) because it provides services that meet specific needs, or they have limited benefits.

## Behavioral Health I/DD Tailored Plans (launching July 2022)


 Tailored Plans will provide the same services as Standard Plans as well as additional specialized services for individuals with significant behavioral health conditions, I/DDs, and traumatic brain injury, as well as people utilizing state-funded and waiver services.

## Most Medicaid beneficiaries will enroll in NC Medicaid Managed Care

Status of Medicaid Managed Care Enrollment, Per Legislation	Populations
Mandatory (Must enroll)	<ul> <li>Most family &amp; children's Medicaid, NC Health Choice, pregnant women, non-Medicare aged, blind, disabled.</li> </ul>
Excluded (Cannot enroll, stay in NC Medicaid Direct)	<ul> <li>Family Planning program, medically needy, health insurance premium payment (HIPP), Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE), refugee Medicaid</li> <li>Some beneficiaries are temporarily excluded and become mandatory later. This includes dually-eligible Medicaid/Medicare, foster care/adoption, &amp; Community Alternatives Programs for Children (CAP/C) and Disabled Adults (CAP/DA).</li> </ul>
Exempt (May enroll or stay in NC Medicaid Direct)	<ul> <li>Federally recognized tribal members, beneficiaries who would be eligible for behavioral health tailored plans (until they become available). Target launch date for Tailored Plans is July 1, 2022.</li> </ul>



## **Auto Enrollment Overview**

- Automated process by which the Department enrolls a beneficiary who has not actively selected a PHP during open enrollment or at application
- State uses six-step enrollment algorithm to assign Managed Care eligible beneficiaries to a PHP or Tribal Option
  - Where the beneficiary lives
  - Whether the beneficiary is a member of a special population
  - Historical provider-beneficiary relationship and preference
  - Health Plan assignments of other family members
  - Previous Health Plan enrollment within the past 12 months
  - Equitable Health Plan distribution




