Referrals for Medicaid transportation must be requested through prepaid health plan. DA Transit receiving referrals, but most do not have required language and are denied.</li> <li>c. Go Cary receiving referrals for clients outside of Cary; no longer accepting referrals.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
